The Surma people, with the Nilotic origin are found in the western shore of the river Omo, at the Border of Omo Park. This region which is almost unknown to tourism is known for the coffee the ancient Sidamo Kingdom region, the region of the subtropical wood and of the Nuer and Anuak tribes.

14th day: Arbaminch-Awassa
15th day: Awassa-Langanoo
16th day Langano-Addis Ababa
